Bunker Renovations: Modernising our bunkers with enhanced drainage, reshaping, and upgraded sand quality.

In addition to our superb course, Crondon Park offers top-tier practice facilities, coaching from a team of PGA Professionals, and a private clubhouse reserved exclusively for our golfing members. We take pride in being a club known for its welcoming atmosphere and forward-thinking approach, making us one of the friendliest clubs in Essex.

Our Championship course, spanning over 6,800 yards from the back tees, presents a formidable challenge for golfers of all skill levels. With 5 par 3s, 5 par 5s, and 8 par 4s, there are opportunities to score well – but only for those ready to tackle its strategic challenges. Water hazards come into play on 9 of the 18 holes, demanding precision and careful course management.

And if that weren't enough, our USGA-standard greens are fast, undulating, and highly receptive, though getting on the wrong side of a pin could be a costly mistake!

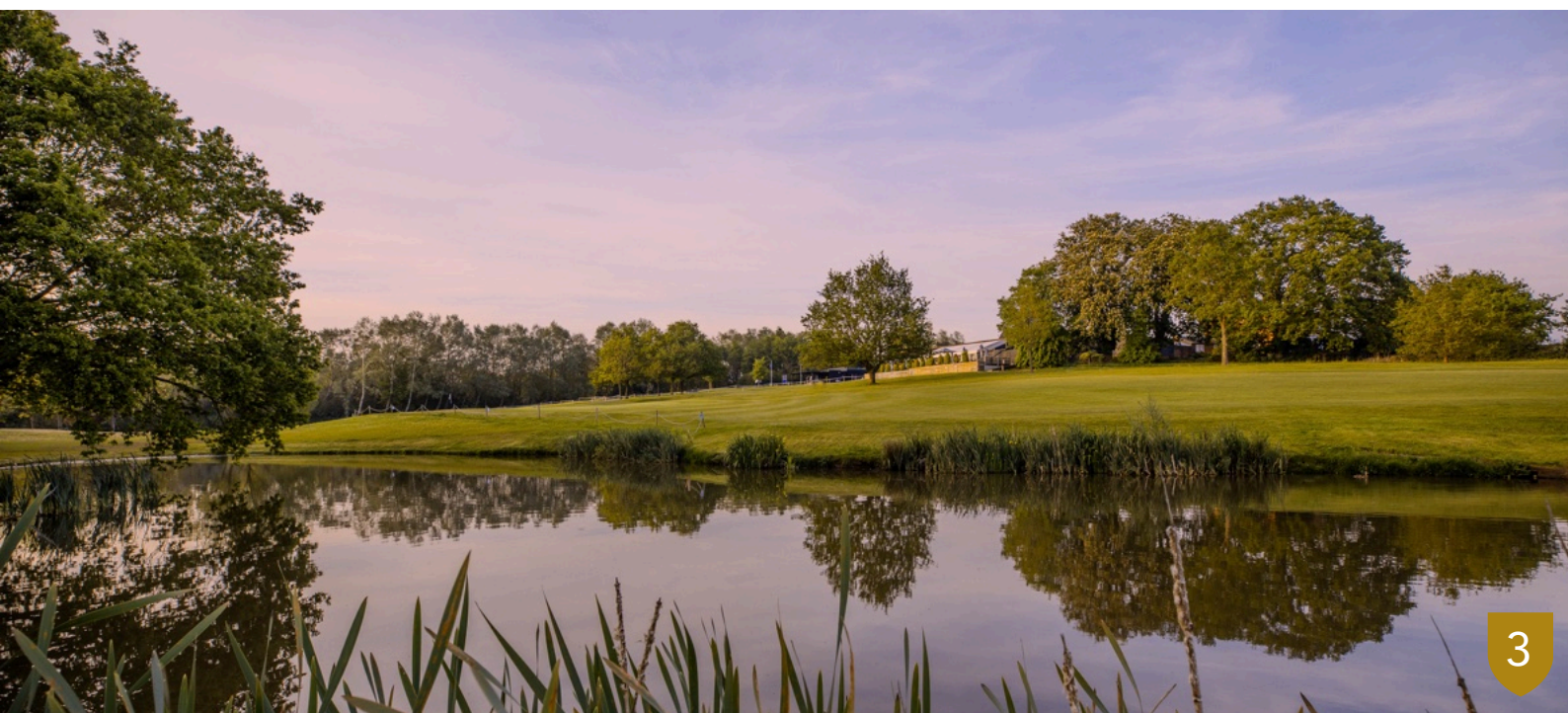

The driving range is self-sufficient, with a card reader for the ball dispenser so anyone can use it at any time.
