Upcoming Course Work

Starting Monday 7th April, we will begin essential greens maintenance. While this will require temporary greens for up to five days, the long-term benefits include healthier, faster, and more consistent putting surfaces. We appreciate your patience as we carry out these vital works.

Additionally, FRA, our drainage contractors, will return for three weeks to complete the snagging process and secondary drainage improvements. This will include finalising work on the 15th hole, adding drainage in persistently wet areas, and connecting additional drainage points to improve walk-off areas. Our goal is to create a drier, more enjoyable playing experience year-round.

7th April will also mark the return of **Project Bunker.** JC Paths will be on-site for five weeks to restore and enhance at least 12 bunkers. These will be reshaped, re-drained, and lined with astroturf, with premium China clay sand introduced to maintain playing consistency.

Looking Ahead: Future Course Plans

We remain dedicated to our five-year plan to establish Crondon Park as one of the finest courses in the region.

Future projects include:

- The full reintroduction of every bunker on the course for a cohesive design and playing experience.
- Implementation of fairway irrigation systems.
- Redevelopment, drainage, and releveling of tee complexes to ensure all-grass tee boxes remain in play year-round.

Clubhouse Upgrades

We recognise that off-course facilities are just as important as the course itself. We are actively working with planning consultants to enhance our clubhouse, with proposed upgrades including:

- A dedicated members' lounge.
- Separate dining areas.
- Modernised changing room facilities in line with our elevated course standards.

Additionally, the main driveway and driving range road are set for resurfacing in the coming months. We also plan to do carry out some remedial works to the car park surface.



Driving Range & Practice Facility Enhancements

Plans are underway to introduce **Trackman Range**, multiple driving range membership options, and a full-service retail club fitting facility. These improvements aim to elevate your practice experience and provide access to cutting-edge golf technology.

Midweek Roll - Ups & Social Groups

Social groups will always be a priority at Crondon, as golf is not only a social sport but also offers numerous health benefits beyond the physical. Fostering a strong community enhances the overall experience for our members, which remains a key focus for us. While recent changes to the membership structure and booking system required social groups to adjust how they organize and secure tee times, we understand the initial concerns regarding peak-time availability. We've received fantastic feedback from members who have booked into the Midweek Roll-Ups, and we're committed to further enhancing these to meet our members' needs. Additionally, we've begun exploring opportunities to introduce Roll-Ups during peak times and align them with club-run competitions. Expanding and promoting the social aspect of the club remains a top priority, ensuring members have a variety of options to enjoy golf—whether playing with friends, in social groups, or in competitive settings.
